





1. Airplane

Useful Phrase: I'd like ~. Can I have~?

FA: Which would you like, beef, fish, or chicken?

You: I'd like beef. Thank you.

FA: Would you like something to drink?

You: Green tea, please. / No thank you.









2. Immigration Examination

Useful Phrase: What~? How~? Where~?

Officer: Show me your passport, please.

You: Here you are.

Officer: What's the purpose of your visit?

You: For Sightseeing.

Officer: How long will you stay in this country?

You: For six days.

Officer: Where are you going to stay?

You: At the Hilton Hotel.

Officer: Do you have a return ticket?

You: Yes, here you are.

Officer: What is your occupation?

You: I'm an office worker.









3. Hotel

Useful Phrase: I'd like to check in.

Clerk: May I help you?

Useful Phrase: May I have~?

Waiter: Hi, are you ready to order?

May I have some water, please?

Waiter: Sure. I'll be right back with that.









5. Sightseeing

Useful Phrase: Could (Would) you~?

You: Excuse me. Could you tell me the way to The Louvre

Museum?

Man: You can go to 3 blocks straight on and turn left.

You: Thank you, and would you take a picture of us?

Man: Of course, sure.









6. Shopping

Useful Phrase: How much ∼?

You: Hello. When the next ferry does to Taiwan is leave?

Clerk: At 10:45. Would you like to buy tickets?

You: Yes, how much are they?

Clerk: The tickets are \$100 each way.

You: OK, we'll take three.

Clerk: Here are your tickets. That'll be \$ 300.

You: Here you go.
