At the Hallway

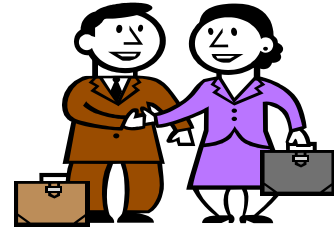
- Mary : Hello, Good morning.

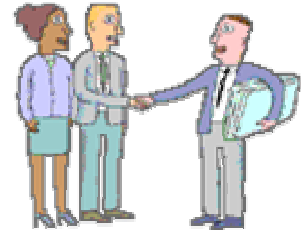
