#### In the store

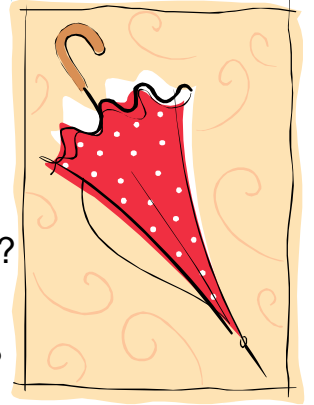
- Front desk Officer : What can I do for you?
